## IMPORTANT NOTICE TO SHAREHOLDERS:

Our attorney has stressed to us the importance of Palm Worth's shareholders letting the Palm Beach City Council know before the June 15th Zoning Meeting that the proposed fence without an access gate to the park would present a hardship to its shareholders and would not solve the documented vandalism, vagrancy and illegal activities occurring at the beach Access 12 entrance where we have stressed the need for, and requested, a locked gate. The County's proposed fence at the North end of the park does not allow for a secured gate at the Access 12 Beach entrance nor at the West end of the fence.

However, reference that Palm Worth is the 50 plus year old adjoining cooperative on the North side of the park and that having access to the park for our elderly shareholders, our wheel chair handicapped, and all of Palm Worth has been theirs for over 20 years and significantly contributes to the value of our property. Without an access gate in the

proposed fence, shareholders will have to go through the parking lot entrance and walk along A1A walking on the shoulder or grass if they are able or walk on the beach until park access is available. Neither option is acceptable for elderly and handicapped.

Without the County providing Palm Worth access to the park for its residents, we cannot support and strongly oppose the Proposed Fencing Project on the North end of Kruesler Park submitted by the County at this time.

In order to prevent our loss of access to the park, it will require Palm Worth to make "noise" at the June 15th City Council Meeting by our letters and having as many shareholders at the meeting as possible. Please copy Marcy with your letters and emails.
