The Board has received several inquiries whether the Board has lifted the "No Visitors" except Shareholders restriction presently in force.

As much as we would like to accommodate and allow all shareholders and their families the use of Palm Worth and its beach, we are by the declared State of Emergency which was extended to the first week of June responsible for the well-being of all shareholders that reside at Palm Worth. In addition, we have conferred with not only our Insurance Agent but also our Attorney concerning our responsibility in protecting Palm Worth and its shareholders.

Therefore, at the present time, the restriction on visitors other than shareholders remains in effect. We will continue to address exceptions when an immediate family member is needed to assist a shareholder in returning to their out of state home. Over the next several weeks, the Board will continue to monitor all the information concerning restrictions from the Town of Palm Beach with the intent to remove the restrictions on immediate family members when possible. However, this would only apply to immediate family members.

At this time, Palm Worth will only allow workers performing essential services such as mail delivery, emergency repairs, air conditioning repairs and service, caregivers and housekeepers for shareholders when necessary. In addition, we are discussing the necessary exterior building repairs with our engineer in preparation for work to be completed once restrictions allow.

It has been an extremely stressful year for many of our shareholders. Please stay safe and healthy!
