

To Shareholders,

As of February 26th, 2021, Governor DeSantis has extended the state of emergency with respect to COVID-19 for another 60 days.

Therefore, Palm Worth's current restrictions, which are as listed, will remain in effect;

- Palm Worth is only open to shareholders and their immediate family. Please be sure to notify me when you or your family are planning a visit
- Masks are mandatory in common areas

Also, Palm Worth continues to battle with vehicles parked on property that do not belong, whether it be from the Tideline, or outsiders using our guest spots as beach parking. As well as the Town of Palm Beach Police Dept who has notified us of frequent car break-ins throughout the island.

With that being said, we are strictly enforcing our parking lot rules and regulations in that, any visitor must have a guest pass displayed in their vehicle at all times when parking on Palm Worth property, even if they are parked in your parking spot.

Guest passes can be found in the mailroom right by the guest sign-in book. Any vehicle that is not properly marked as a visitor of Palm Worth will be issued one warning, and then towed off of the property at the vehicle owner's expense.
