

HAVE YOU READ THE HOUSE RULES AND BYLAWS!

This is not acceptable recycling as left. Shareholders need to take this type of materials, old carpets, paint cans, etc. to the Lantana Dump located across from Costco. In addition, all trash sent down the trash chutes must be in appropriate plastic trash bags. Liquor bottles, plastic containers, pizza boxes thrown down the chutes are not acceptable since it causes blockage of the chutes with trash backing up the chute. This presents a problem to all shareholders until our maintenance person is able to clear the drop.

Also, no food is allowed at the pool except on Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday after 5 pm. Recently, again, it was necessary to call Orkin to check for rodents. There are 2 very important and considerate reasons why this House Rule benefits the shareholders at Palm Worth.

1. In the past, the continuous amount of food, etc. left daily on tables and the pool deck created a rat situation under the grill and on the pool deck. Our maintenance people, as well as concerned shareholders, have been able to control this situation with the present 3 day restriction.

2. Palm Worth is a residence and the buildings are built around the pool and pool deck area. Consideration of all the residents as far as the amount of noise generated from continuous use every evening of the pool deck must be taken into consideration. This rule benefits all the shareholders and not just a few.

And - the “No Swimming” after dark is regulated by the State. Our Commercial Pool License is posted in the office which specifies “no swimming after dark”.

The ByLaws and House Rules, many of which are dictated by Florida regulations, have protected and continued to make Palm Worth a desirable and special gem on the ocean. Please remember this is communal living and consider all the shareholders when present at Palm Worth.
